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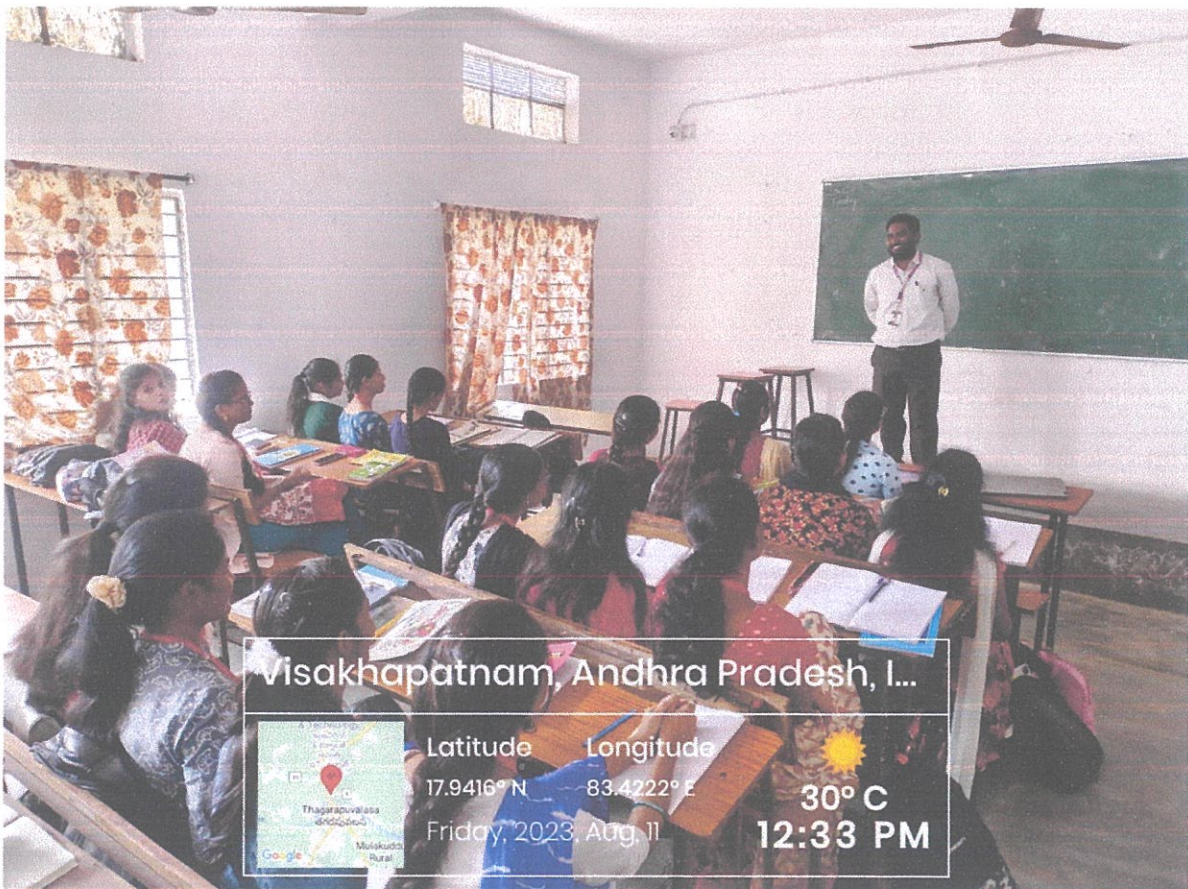

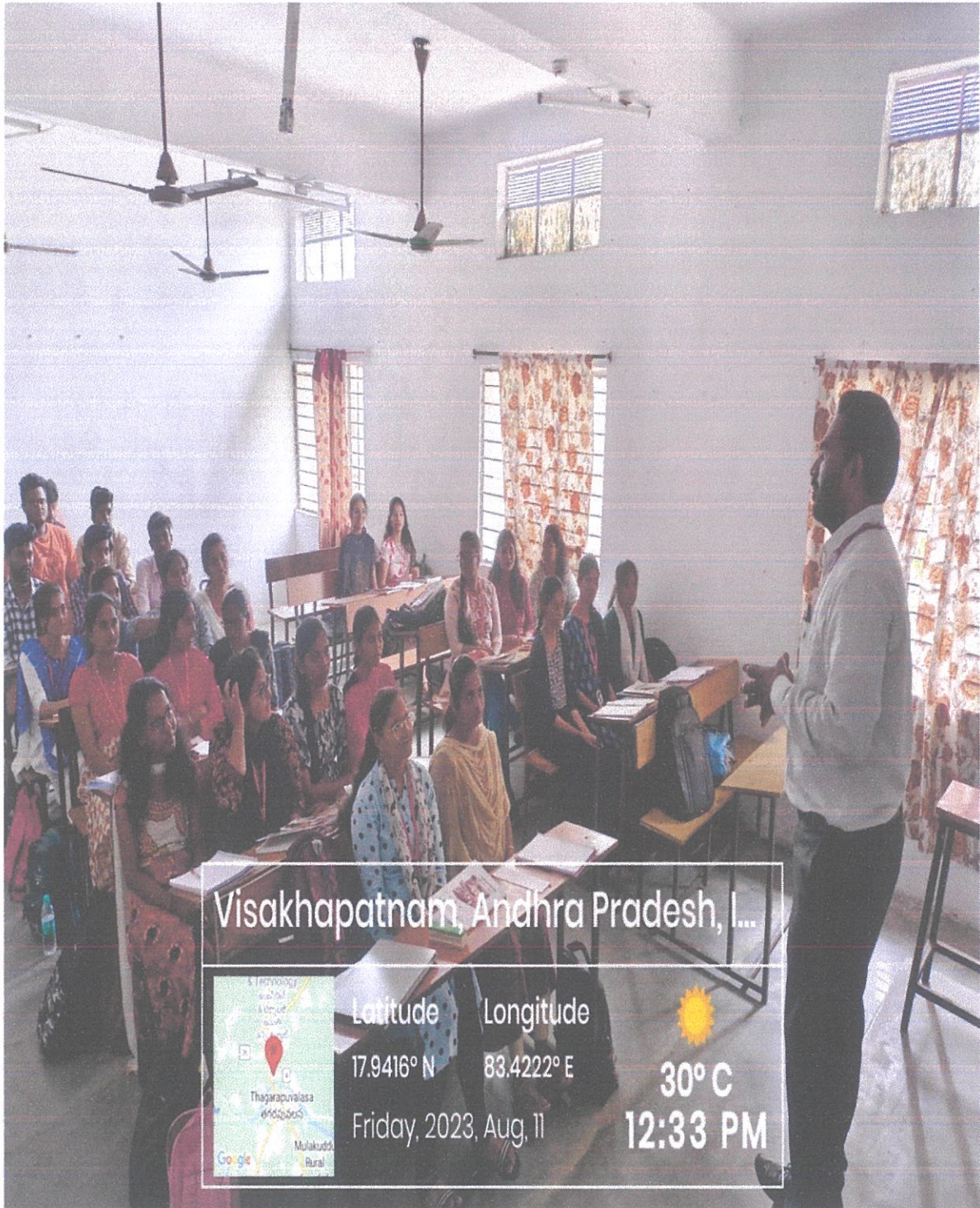

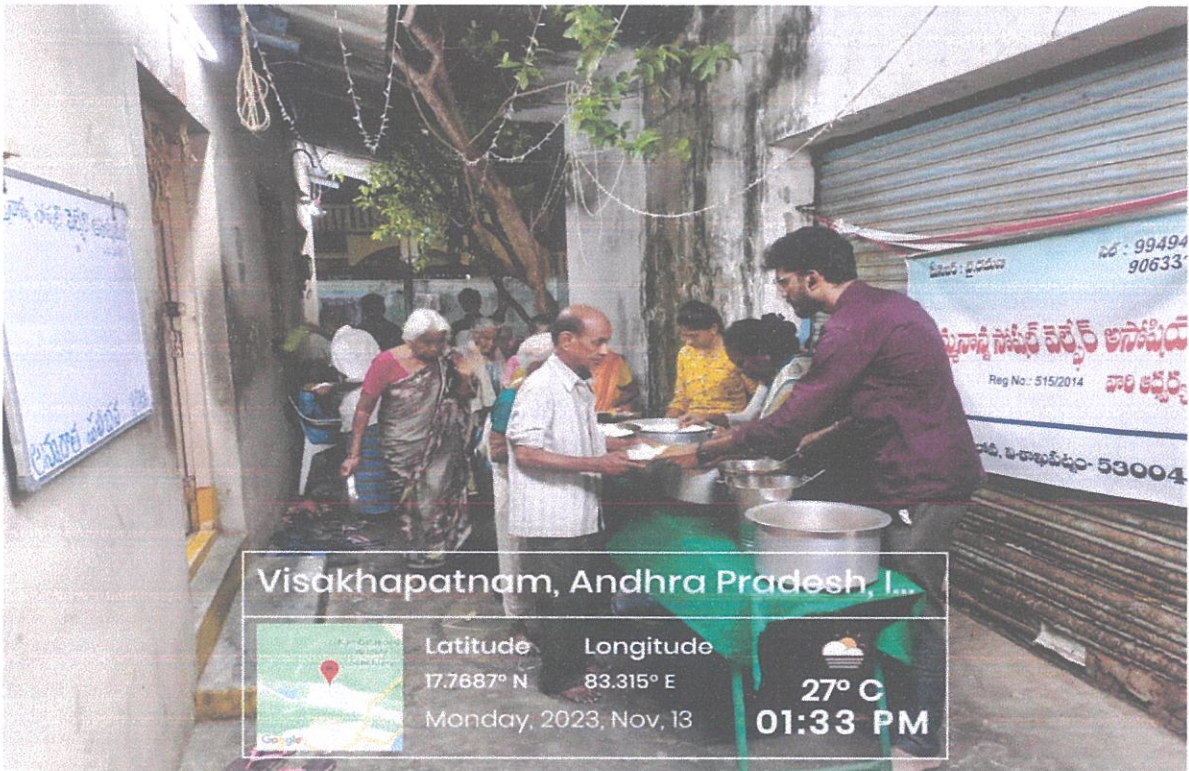

- A collective pledge by students to adopt sustainable practices in their daily lives.

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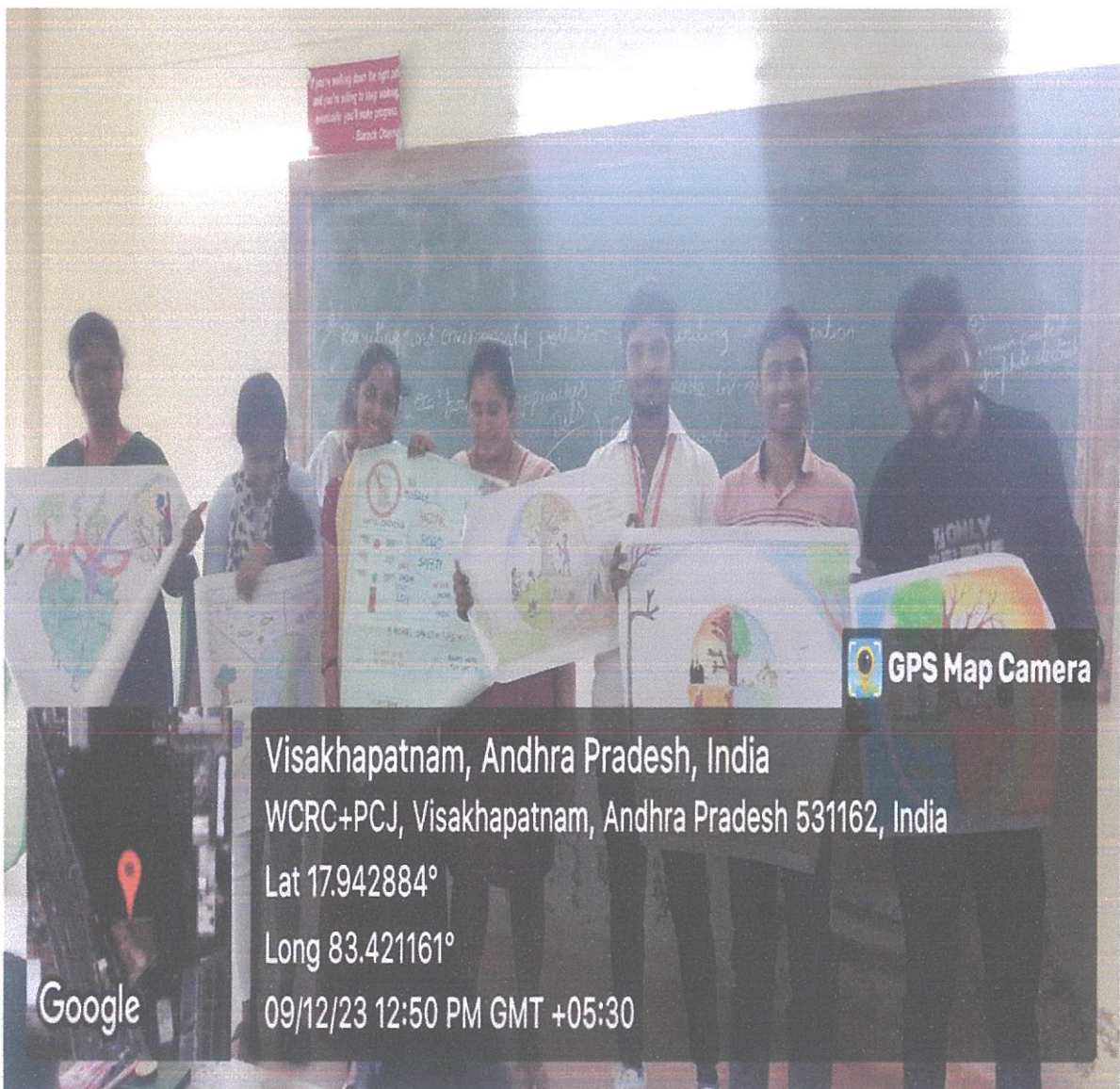
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Conclusion:
